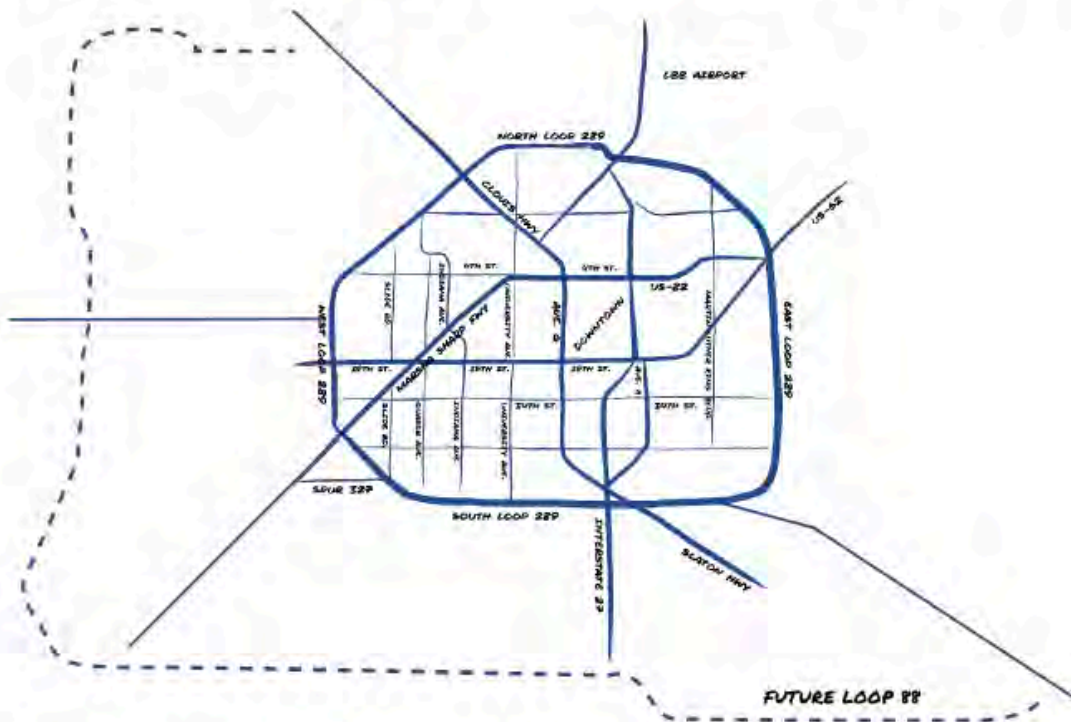

GETTING AROUND BY CAR

With a 17-minute average commute time navigating the city is incredibly convenient. Loop 289 encompasses the city making it easy to get from one end to the other, and Loop 88, which will be the outer loop, is currently under construction. Marsha Sharp Freeway cuts through the city from the southwest to the northeast making it easy to get from outside of the city to Texas Tech University and downtown Lubbock. Most of the streets that run north to south are alphabetical and the streets that run east to west are numerical.



GETTING AROUND BY BUS

Lubbock is served by Citibus, a public transportation service that has fixed routes to all major retail, medical, educational and employment areas within the city. The fixed schedules and routes are listed at citibus.com. For long-distance travel, Greyhound services a location in Lubbock.



AIRPORTS

Lubbock Preston Smith International Airport sits 15 minutes on the north side of the city. Major airlines such as American, Southwest and United fly in. Lubbock offers direct flights to Dallas, Albuquerque, Austin, Las Vegas, Houston, Denver and Phoenix. For private airports, there are the following options: ClearTech Aviation at Lubbock Executive Airport and Lubbock Aero.



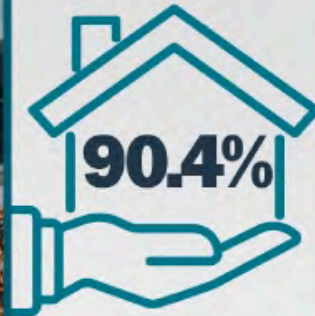
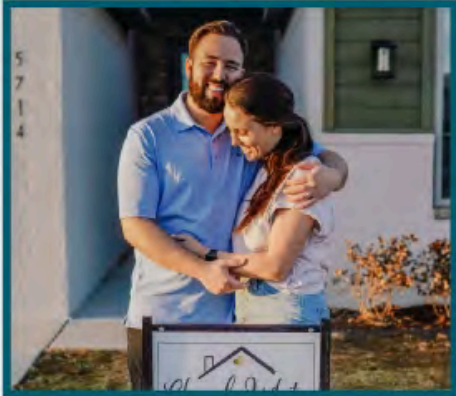

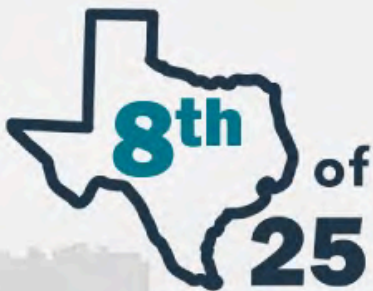

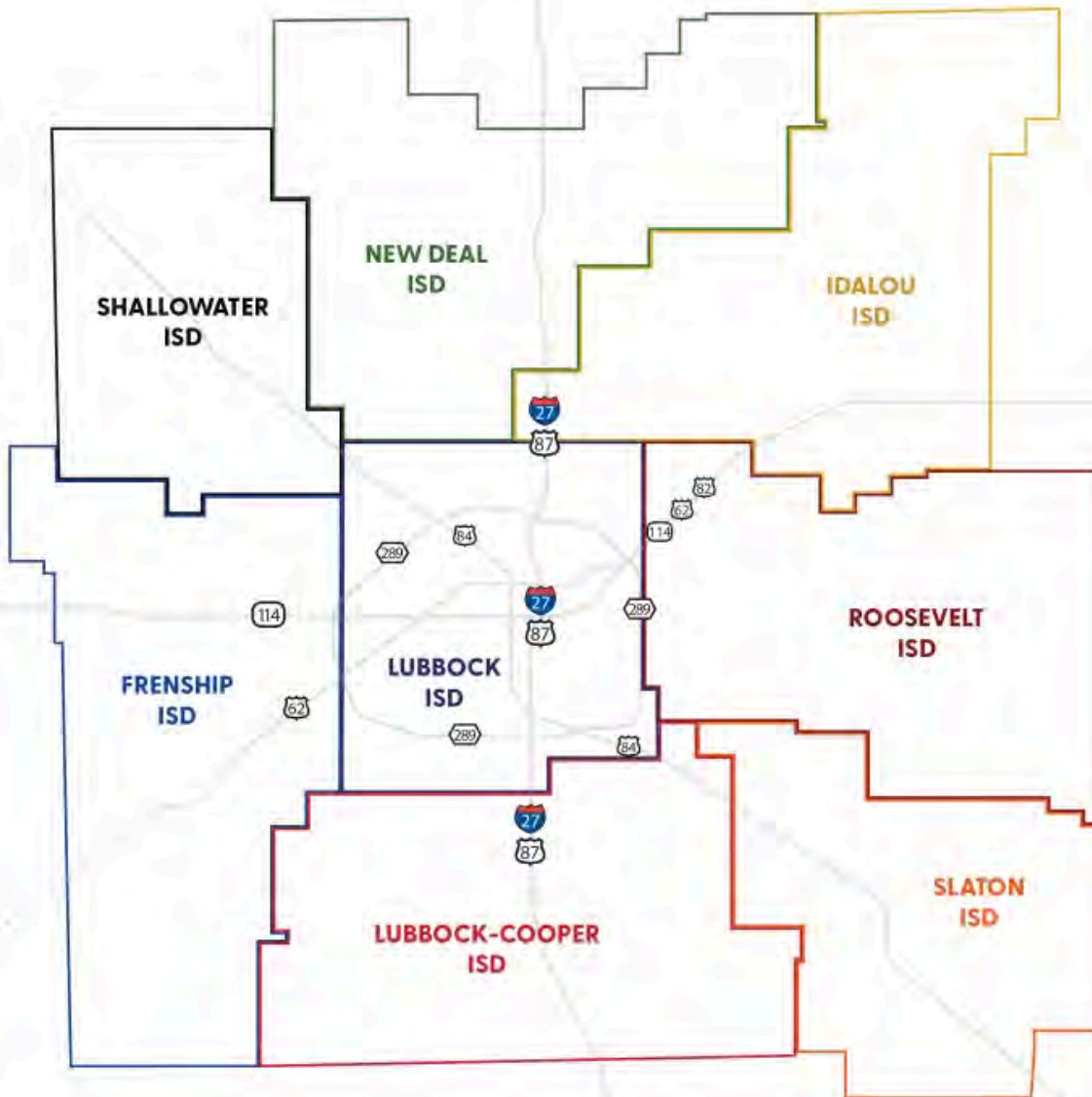

A GUIDE TO **LUBBOCK'S FIRST FRIDAY ART TRAIL**

The ultimate connection to the creative community of the LBK is a trip to Lubbock's First Friday Art Trail (FFAT), a must for art connoisseurs and foodies alike. Whether it's meeting local artists, browsing internationally acclaimed work, or eating dinner with friends from a local food truck, this monthly event is every local's favorite event.



GETTING AROUND / On the first Friday of every month, rain or shine, the event kicks off at 6 p.m. A good starting point is the hub of the trail, LHUCA, at 511 Ave. K. From here, you can hop on a free trolley which services the rest of the Arts District into the Business District and Depot Entertainment District, as well as other venues spanning from 4th Street to 19th Street.

WHAT TO EXPECT / There is no admission fee for the trail, but you'll need your wallet for purchases from a food truck as well as any art you decide to add to your collection. As for what to wear, you will see a range of styles from work wear to casual attire. The main consideration, as with every partially outdoor event, is the weather.

ART ON DISPLAY / At FFAT, many of the exhibits allow you to meet and talk with the artist. This provides the unique opportunity to discuss the process and inspiration behind their work. Oftentimes, artists have demonstrations to interact with as well. A great place to start for this one-on-one experience is the Charles Adams Studio Project.

DON'T MISS / From Two Docs Brewing Co. to Juxtaposh, the trail is lined with a variety of venues ready to entertain. Several downtown restaurants including Rave On, located inside The Buddy Holly Hall of Performing Arts and Sciences, and Claraboya Scratch Kitchen, inside the DoubleTree hotel, participate in FFAT. And, if you want to continue the night with a musical performance, check out The Blue Light Live, Cactus Theater and The Garden for shows. Make sure to tag us on social and share your #FFAT experience!

Note: This event is dog friendly, although not every participating location may have a spot for your pup (i.e. indoor dining).



MUST-SEE **MUSEUMS**

Lucky us, Lubbock is full of interactive, family-friendly museums. With the largest collection of windmills in the world and a pair of iconic frames that stand out from the rest, there's always somewhere new to explore right around the corner. Whether you want a unique form of entertainment for the day or have parents, grandparents or in-laws coming to town, plan a day full of interactive learning and exploration.

AMERICAN WINDMILL MUSEUM / The largest collection of windmills in the world is in our backyard at the American Windmill Museum. Become immersed in the pioneering spirit of Lubbock, Texas through exhibits and art including the 6,000-square-foot hand-painted mural titled Legacy of the Wind.

BUDDY HOLLY CENTER / Immersing yourself in Lubbock's culture as a local means you can't miss the exhibit dedicated to the life and music of Lubbock's favorite son and rock'n'roll legend, Buddy Holly. View memorabilia donated by family, friends and fans of Buddy's including the iconic glasses found at the site of the airplane crash. Just adjacent to the Center is the J.I. Allison House which is known as the site where Buddy and The Crickets wrote the hit, That'll Be The Day.

CAVIEL MUSEUM OF AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY / Named after the former owners of the building and the first African American husband and wife to own and operate their own pharmacy in the U.S., Alfred and Billie Caviel, the Caviel Museum of African American History is dedicated to celebrating art, culture and identity with artwork from Africa and antiques donated by community members.

FIBERMAX CENTER FOR DISCOVERY / With a cotton harvesting experience, an exhibit featuring women in agriculture, an impressive lineup of over 700 toy tractors and a replica of a blacksmith shop, be immersed in an array of interactive exhibits at the FiberMax Center for Discovery. Learn the West Texas history and its impact on American agriculture at this must-see museum.



LUBBOCK LAKE NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK / Did you know you can step back into prehistoric times at Lubbock Lake Landmark? Dating back 12,000 years, this museum showcases exhibitions featuring Ice Age creatures and outdoor trails to admire nature and wildflowers. Make sure to check out the archeological trail and get your picture with the iconic mammoth just outside the museum. During summer, be sure to take part in a Landmark After Dark Hike!

MUSEUM OF TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY / From pottery and textiles to dinosaur replicas and Ice Age creatures, the Museum of Texas Tech is a great place for admirers of the arts and history buffs alike. As you peruse the rotating exhibits, don't miss the Moody Planetarium, where you'll be transported out of this world with educational shows highlighting the stars and constellations.

NATIONAL RANCHING HERITAGE CENTER / Telling the history of ranching in Texas is this museum's claim to fame. Here, locals come back time and time again to explore the 19-acre historical park with over 50 authentically restored ranch structures as well as rotating exhibits inside the main building. Make sure to mark your calendar for the Center's spring event, Ranch Day, which depicts everyday ranch life, and its December event, Candlelight at the Ranch, which shows what a yuletide season was like in the Old West.

SILENT WINGS MUSEUM / Honor the history of the U.S. World War II glider program and see one of the few fully restored glider planes in existence. The Silent Wings Museum also features a C-47 airplane and multimedia theater that explains the history of this military operation and pays tribute to the freedom we enjoy today.

SCIENCE SPECTRUM & OMNI THEATER / The Science Spectrum is a hands-on experience offering insights into basic principles of science like pulleys, electrical circuits and more. Check out the children's museum with a vet clinic, sensory play and plenty of space to explore! Not to mention, this attraction brings in engaging community events like Critter Fest and educational films at its on-site Omni Theater.



SENSORY FRIENDLY SPACES

From sunny days spent adventuring outside to indoor play spaces, there are several sensory-friendly areas in your own backyard.

WE ROCK THE SPECTRUM KID'S GYM / With trampolines, swings, ziplines, arts and crafts, and more, this gym is made with the purpose of exercising and stimulating the seven senses through positive social, emotional and physical development. The space offers open play, parties and classes that provide social skills groups and activities for children across the spectrum. The cost is \$14 per child or visitors can purchase an all-day pass of \$20.

ADVENTURE PARK / A full calendar of seasonal events means there is never a dull moment at Adventure Park. Accommodations for accessibility include handicapped walkways, two-seater go-karts, bumper boats and more. Make sure you wear closed-toed shoes so you can make the most of your adventure!



MILESTONES DEVELOPMENT & PLAY PARK / Milestones Development and Play Park prides itself on being a place where parents can connect with their children and kids can experience the true joy of play together, embracing each other's unique gifts. The park is home to six one-of-a-kind play areas inside, including a rock wall, Jungle Safari, Home Center, Candy Land and Infant Patch.

SCIENCE SPECTRUM & OMNI THEATER / With over 250 hands-on science exhibits and shows, any age will find something new to enjoy at the Science Spectrum. This non-profit is home to the OMNI Theater, The Lubbock Children's Museum, and Lubbock's only public aquarium. Its website is a great resource for accessible exhibits, special events and classes!

PLAY STREET MUSEUM / This educational play space is a great way for parents to connect and have a safe environment for kids to thrive. With a town square and interactive exhibits, kids are free to use their imaginations and creatively play, discover and problem-solve. Be sure to stay up to date with its Facebook page to know when designated sensory-friendly play is!

LUBBOCK PREMIERE IMAX / Be sure to check for sensory-friendly showings of popular movies. During the showings, the theater will turn the lights up and the volume down so moviegoers can get up and dance or sing along to the featured flick without fear of being overwhelmed.



GET CREATIVE IN THE LBK

Lubbock is home to a thriving arts community, with several studios offering classes and workshops for those interested in exploring their creativity.

LHUCA CLAY STUDIO offers classes in ceramics for all skill levels. From hand-building to wheel-throwing, students can learn a variety of techniques and create unique pieces of art. Options include six week intro to throw and intro to sculpture classes as well as drop-in classes.

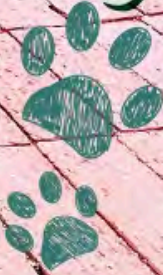

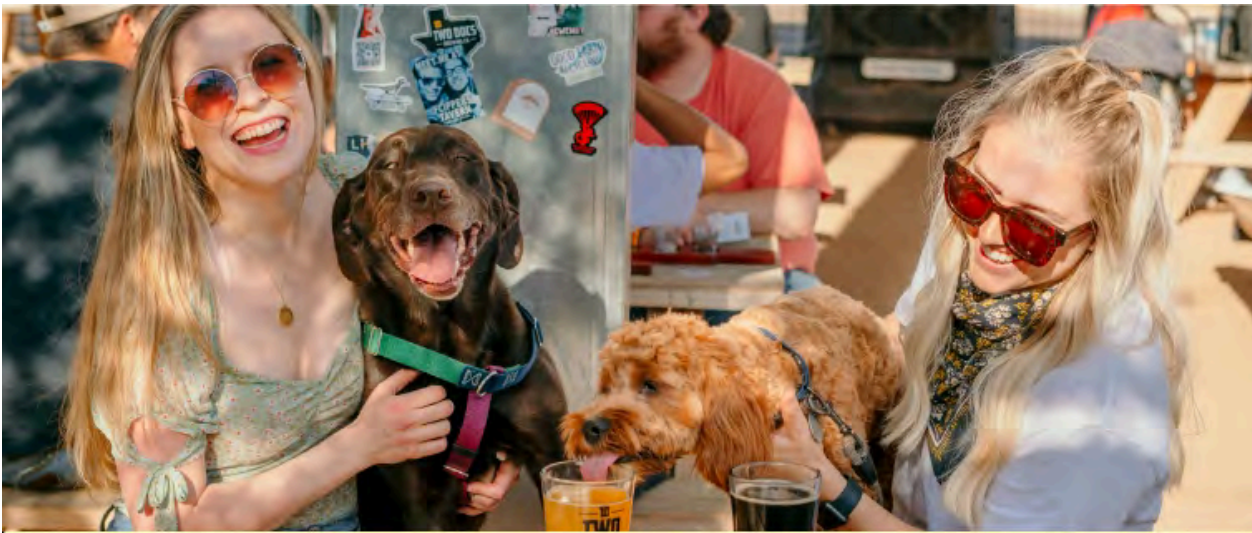

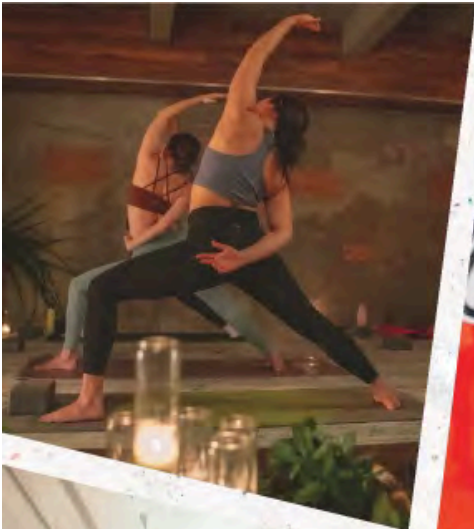
